

HOME BUSH.

BOUNDARIES—County of Cumberland, parishes of Concord and Liberty Plains; area about one mile, commencing on the centre of the railway line from Parramatta to Sydney at a south-eastern corner of the Municipality of Rookwood; and bounded thence by part of the eastern boundary of that municipality and its continuation generally north-easterly to the south-western boundary of the Municipality of Concord;

thence by that boundary and the south-western boundary of the annexation to the latter municipality generally south-easterly to the western boundary of Burwood Municipality; thence by that boundary southerly to the northern boundary of the Municipality of Strathfield; thence by that boundary and the northern boundary of the annexation to that municipality generally westerly, to the point of commencement.
